


## Travelling to Ladywood Leisure Centre

### Arriving by car

Birmingham has recently imposed a clean air zone for the City Centre (see map). The pool itself is located just outside the clean air zone however, please check your route or your vehicle to ensure you're not receiving a charge. You will not need to pay and will not be charged if your vehicle meets specified emission standards. You can check your vehicle here: <https://www.gov.uk/clean-air-zones>



## Parking

Parking at the pool is limited however, there are several large car parks within a 10-15min walk from the pool:

With limited parking at the pool, getting a taxi may be the best option to get from accommodation to the pool. Both Uber and Ola taxi services operate in Birmingham, with other normal taxi services also available.

## Arriving by train

Grand Central New Street is the main station in the city. There are options to get a train (five ways station) or tram (library station) closer to the pool however, this will still leave you with a 20+min walk, so it may be easier to get a taxi from Grand Central itself.

## Hotels

**City centre** - The closest hotel to the pool is **Travelodge Birmingham Central (Broadway Plaza)** at approximately a 10min walk. There is plenty of parking on site and there are a couple of restaurants within the Broadway Plaza complex but is also within walking distance of many restaurants located within the city centre.

The next nearest hotels are located in the city centre, approximately 20-25min walk (5min drive) from the pool but are located within busy areas for nightlife in Birmingham on the weekend. There are plenty of options in this area and at a reasonable price for the city centre however, it might be best to avoid the Broad Street area if you want the best chance of a quiet night.

*(Check parking availability at the hotel; due to their location, it may be limited)*

**Hagley road** - another few options are located on the Hagley Road. A main road into the city from the M5, the Hagley Road is a good location for accessing the pool by car however, it is more limited in terms of hotel options as well as restaurants, unless there is an on-site restaurant at the hotel itself.

Premier inn Birmingham Central (Hagley road) - 23min walk

**Jewellery Quarter** - located slightly further from the pool is the Jewellery Quarter. This is a nice area, much quieter than the City Centre with a good number of independent restaurants. There are limited options in the way of hotels in this area but there are also serviced apartments, which may be a good option if you're interested in self-catered facilities.

**5min drive/20+min walk**

**Other** - whilst there are many hotels in the City Centre within a 30min walk of the pool, if you don't fancy navigating City Centre traffic on a Friday night there are options on the outskirts of the City. The NEC/Resorts World (by Birmingham International Airport) in particular has a wide range of hotels and restaurants.

## **Supermarkets**

## **Food**

### **Lunch**

There will be no catering on site at present so, we suggest bringing your own food for the day, alternatively there is a Subway just down the road at Broadway Plaza (12min walk).

### **Evening restaurants**

Evening meals will ultimately depend on where your accommodation is based, with many good options throughout the city. Should you be wanting to eat out for an evening meal, we would suggest booking well in advance as you may struggle to find somewhere and get seated at a decent time, especially if there are a larger number of you as part of a team.
